



2020-2021 Corner Conference Winter Activities Regulations

General Guidelines:

- **Masks and social distancing will be required of all non-participating spectators during the winter athletic contests.**
- Game announcers will give frequent reminders of the COVID-19 guidelines during events.
- All spectators are responsible for screening their own health before attending events. If you feel sick, please stay home.

Contest Information:

- Masks are required for all non-participants and spectators during all JH, JV, and Varsity basketball games.
- The first two rows will not be available for spectator seating. Areas will be marked off in each gym where seating is not allowed.
- The conference is limiting attendance at these activities, per the most recent proclamation from Governor Reynolds. **Spectators are limited to six tickets per participant (player, cheerleader, dance team member, pep band member) and coach.** Tickets will be handed to the student participants. Participants and coaches will be responsible for handing out the tickets to guests and collecting/re-issuing the tickets for each game.
- Spectators will pay the following admission fees:
 - \$3 for all JH conference matches; \$5 for all JV/V conference matches.
 - Exact change is highly recommended, and spectators will wear masks and follow social distancing when waiting in line.
- **We will clear the gym between games.** Spectators will need to leave after their student has competed, performed, etc. You must have a ticket for the next game for re-entry.

Concession Stand Guidance:

- When ordering from the concession stand, please maintain social distancing in line.
- When possible, we ask for you to use exact change at the concession stand.
- There will not be seating near the concession stand. Spectators will take food/drink back to the gym area.

Media Guidance:

- The media will maintain social distancing of 6 feet during interviews, and must wear masks while attending events. Members of the media should contact the school prior to attending the event.

When attending events, please remember:

- Wash your hands frequently and avoid touching your face.
- If you feel sick, please stay home and monitor your symptoms.
- Please maintain social distancing at events and wear masks.
